Bevan Road Progressing Well

The main focus of the work along Bevan Road so far has been installation of the water main and storm drains. Excavation has also started for the sidewalk and curbing. Paving is expected to begin at the end of May, with landscape prep and line painting to follow in early June. While working within the historical infrastructure has been challenging, the Village's contractor, Wacor Holdings Ltd., is making good progress.

It is anticipated that Bevan Road will once again open to general traffic in early June. This should lessen traffic flow through the residential neighbourhoods bordering Bevan. The sidewalk will be completed during the summer months with limited impact on vehicle traffic.

The start-up to any large construction project is often disruptive and confusing. Thank you to everyone for your patience and support as the Village works to renew aging infrastructure.



Dunsmuir Avenue Receives Fresh Paint

Just in time for Victoria Day celebrations, the Dunsmuir portion of the Village Upgrades project is nearing completion. A new stop sign was installed at Third Street, bike lanes are clearly marked, angle parking is in place at Village Park, and landscaping is underway.

The contractor is currently finishing up deficiencies, which will see the sidewalk and curb replaced at Fourth Street and also at Third Street. Deficiencies are to be expected and are covered under the contractor's one year warranty. Planting of the new trees on Dunsmuir is also scheduled to take place over the next few weeks.



Fast Facts - Bevan and Cumberland Road Upgrades

- Work includes road and shoulder widening, new base materials, asphalt paving, sidewalks, bike lanes, formal turning lanes, drainage improvements and replacement of the existing water distribution system.
- Site length is approximately 350 metres on Bevan Road, from intersection of Wellington Street to Cumberland Road and approximately 1.0 km of Cumberland Road, from intersection at Bevan Road to near intersection with Union Road.





Detour Reminder

- The general traffic detour route will take effect once work begins on Cumberland Road (anticipated the week of May 23).
- Local traffic to businesses/residences in the construction area will always have access along Cumberland Road.
- General traffic accessing Cumberland's downtown, and the waste management centre (commercial or otherwise), will be detoured along Union Road to Royston Road and onto Dunsmuir Avenue.
- Detour route will be in effect Monday to Friday, from 7am to 7pm.



Dashboard Passes Available

- Dashboard passes have been produced for residents and businesses in the construction zone to allow traffic controllers to easily identify motorists requiring access to Cumberland Road.
- Businesses may wish to provide these passes to their regular and repeat customers
