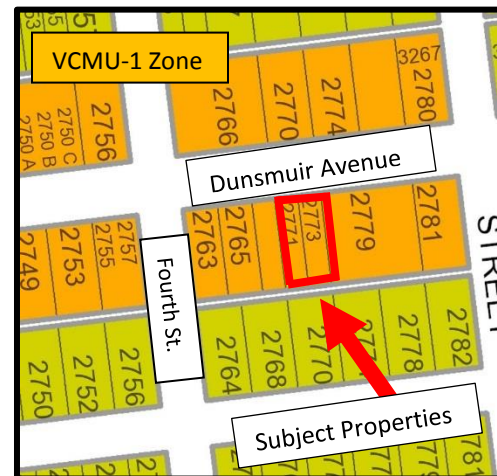

Two applications have been received regarding the properties located at 2771 Dunsmuir Avenue and 2773 Dunsmuir Avenue (shown on the map). The amendments to the Zoning Bylaw, if successful, will permit Vacation Rentals (defined as a dwelling unit used to provide accommodation to the traveling public) as a principal use on the subject properties.

**Bylaw No. 1087 and Bylaw No. 1088:** The general purpose of the Bylaws is to amend 'Zoning Bylaw No. 1027, 2016' to permit Vacation Rentals as a permitted use in the Village Core Commercial Mixed Use Zone (VCMU-1) for the two subject properties only.

A copy of the proposed bylaws and related information may be viewed at the Village office, located at 2673 Dunsmuir Avenue, Cumberland, BC between the hours of 8:30am and 4:30pm, Monday through Friday, excluding statutory holidays.



Anyone who believes their interests are affected by the proposed Bylaws is encouraged to attend the Public Hearing or make a written submission. At the Public Hearing, people will be afforded an opportunity to be heard on matters contained in the Bylaws. Please note that legal considerations prevent the Village Council from considering any representations made after the Public Hearing is closed. Written comments may be submitted to the Village at any time up until the close of the Public Hearing. Please note that all submissions related to the Bylaws and the Public Hearing will form part of the public record.
