Qualifications for Office

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day October 15, 2022;
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed;
- For nomination as mayor or councillor, not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.
 - For nomination as school trustee, not disqualified under the *School Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or being nominated for, being elected to or holding office as a trustee, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

Campaign Period Expense Limits

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act* for the 2022 general local election the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply:

Mayor \$10,797.83 Councillor \$5,398.92 School Trustee \$5,398.92

Third Party Advertising Limits

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2022 general local elections, the following third party advertising limits apply:
