Elector Response Form **Alternative Approval Process (AAP) 2024** **Cumberland Wastewater Upgrade Project**

By completing this elector response form, I am indicating that I **oppose** the adoption of “Wastewater Upgrade Project Loan Authorization No. 2 Bylaw No. 1207, 2024” that authorizes the borrowing of up to an additional \$2,500,000 to be repaid over a period not exceeding 20 years in order to finance the costs of construction of the wastewater upgrade project, unless the Council obtains elector approval through assent voting.

- am a Canadian citizen and am at least 18 years of age or older,
- am a resident of British Columbia and have been for at least 6 months,
- am not disqualified by law from voting,
- have not previously signed an elector response form with respect to this bylaw.

Elector response forms must be submitted by the deadline to the Corporate Officer at the Village office at Box 340, 2673 Dunsmuir Avenue, Cumberland, BC V0R 1S0.

The Council may proceed with the adoption of “*Wastewater Upgrade Project Loan Authorization No. 2 Bylaw No. 1207, 2024*” unless 348 electors sign and submit a completed elector response form by the deadline.

Elector Eligibility

In order to sign an elector response form in relation to the alternative approval process, a person must either be a *resident elector* or a *non-resident property elector*.

RESIDENT ELECTOR

A resident elector is an individual who is entitled to sign an elector response form during an AAP by virtue of living within the Village of Cumberland. When signing an elector response form, a resident elector must:

- be 18 years of age or older,
- be a Canadian citizen,
- have been a resident of British Columbia for at least six months,
- be a resident of the Village of Cumberland,
- live in the area defined for the AAP,
- not be disqualified under the *Local Government Act*, or any other enactment from voting in a local election, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTOR

A non-resident property elector is an individual that **does not live in the Village of Cumberland** and who is entitled to sign an elector response form during an AAP by virtue of owning property in the Village of Cumberland. When signing an elector response form, a non-resident property elector must:

- be 18 years of age or older,
- be a Canadian citizen,
- have been a resident of British Columbia for at least six months,
- be a registered owner of property in the Village of Cumberland for at least 30 days,
- own property in the area defined for the AAP,
- not be disqualified under the *Local Government Act*, or any other enactment from voting in a local election, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

Note: Only **one** non-resident property elector per property may sign an elector response form, regardless of how many people own the property. That owner must have the written consent of a majority of the other property owners to sign the response form on their behalf. The Village of Cumberland has forms available for non-resident property electors to use when gaining written consent from the other property owners for this AAP. **Property owned in whole or in part by a corporation does not qualify under the non-resident property elector provisions.**
