Calls for Service

In the first quarter of the 2024 – 2025 fiscal year, there were 215 Calls for Service in Cumberland. This was a 10 percent (23 file) decrease from Calls for Service in the first quarter of the previous fiscal year.

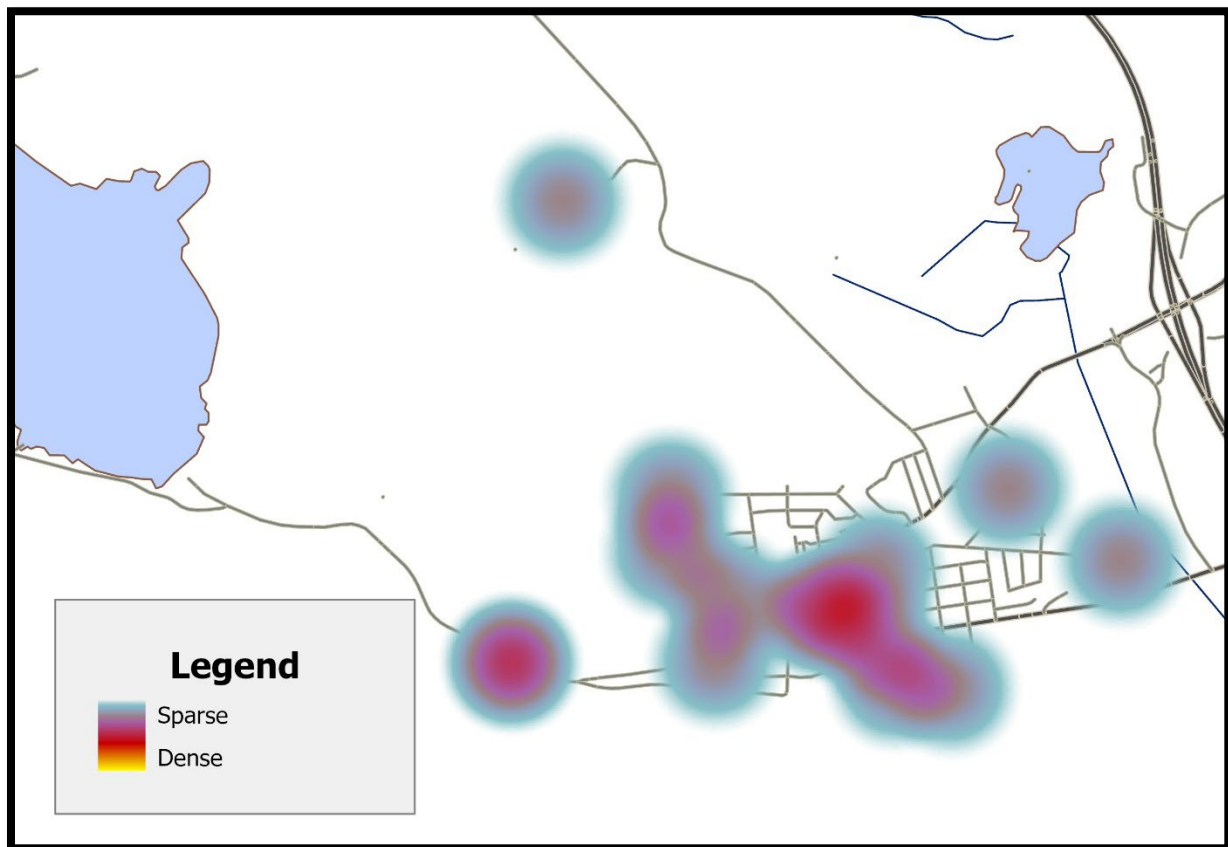
Types of Violent Crime

Property Crime

In the first quarter of the 2024 – 2025 fiscal year, there were 41 Property Crime files in Cumberland. This was 7 files more than the 34 Property Crime files in the first quarter of the previous year.

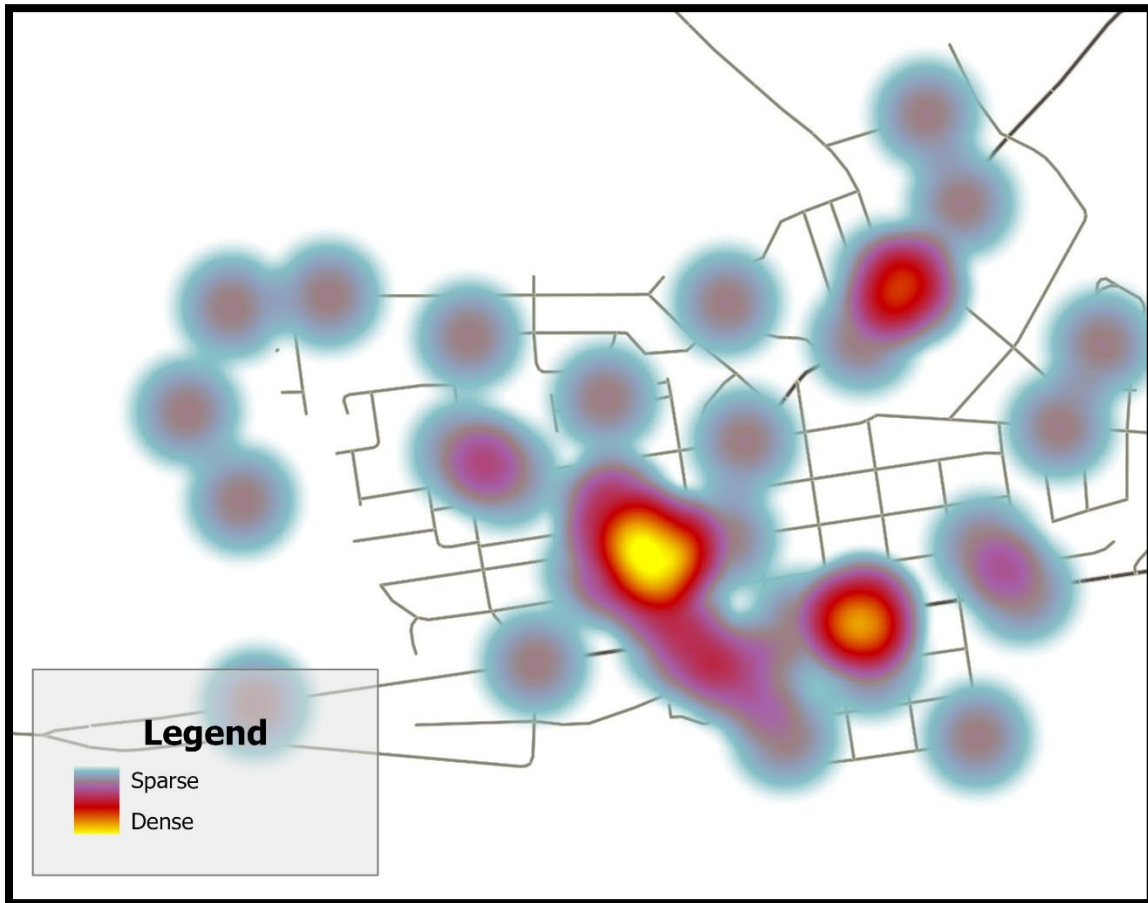
Types of Property Crime

In the first quarter of the 2024 – 2025 fiscal year, the most common type of Property Crime in Cumberland was Mischief to Property. Relative to the first quarter of the previous fiscal year, there was a 6-file increase in Other Thefts Under \$5000. These files are typically thefts of items that were not inside buildings or vehicles.
