Solid Waste Collection

Containers

Please make sure all solid waste containers (garbage and organics) have lids and keep all (garbage, recycling, and organics) containers within these limits:

Maximum volume: 77 liters / Maximum weight: 22 kg

Organics and Yard Waste

Organics are collected from residences weekly. You can line your container with newspaper to help keep it clean.

Garbage – One Container

Bi-weekly collection of household items that cannot go in organics, yard waste, or recycling.

An additional two bags can be added by purchasing tags from the Village Office for \$2.00 each.

Stickers to help identify organics and recycling containers are available at the Village office.

What goes in: All food scraps, food-soiled paper and yard trimmings

- Meat & Bones
- Fish & Shellfish
- Grains & Pasta
- Dairy Products
- Eggs & Shells
- Plate Scrapings
- Fruit & Veggies
- Food-Soiled Paper & Cardboard
- Coffee Filters, Grounds & Tea Bags
- Yard Waste

What stays out: Plastic, including biodegradable or compostable plastic, and pet waste

- NO Plastic, even if labeled biodegradable or compostable
- NO Coffee Cups
- NO Metal, Rubber or Glass
- NO Diapers or Baby Wipes
- NO Pet Waste or Kitty Litter

Place out by 8 a.m. on Collection Day
Recycling Only
Container must have a lid and good handles for lifting. Maximum weight 22kg (50lbs)

ORGANICS COMPOST PROGRAM

Be Bear Aware

To avoid attracting bears to your solid waste, please store your containers in an animal proof location until collection day and set out your containers on collection day by 8:00 am and not the night before.

Newspaper and flyers, magazines, office paper and cardboard

Containers

Aluminum cans, plastic jugs, frozen dessert containers, milk/cream containers and plastic jars and lids

Other

Aluminum foil, aerosol cans (empty), plastic cutlery and plastic straws

Glass

Non-deposit bottles and jars

Hazardous Materials

Items containing motor oil, antifreeze, gasoline and paint

Other

Styrofoam packaging and meat trays, film plastic, plastic plant pots and scrap metal

Please ensure that all recycling is clean.
