ELECTOR REGISTRATION, QUALIFICATIONS and REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

To vote as an elector of the Village of Cumberland you do not have to pre-register. Elector registration takes place at the time of voting.

Bring **two pieces of identification**, at least one with a signature to the voting place. Picture identification is not necessary.

**Resident electors** do not need to own property to vote. Identification must prove both residency and identity.

In order to register to vote, you will be required to make a declaration that you meet the following requirements:

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day, October 17, 2026
- Canadian citizen
- resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding the day of registration
- resident of the Village of Cumberland on the day of registration OR, if a non-resident property elector, a registered owner of real property in the Village of Cumberland for at least 30 days immediately preceding the day of registration, and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

**Non-resident property electors**, who do not reside in Cumberland, must also declare that you are not entitled to register as a resident elector, must produce **2 pieces of identification** at least one with a signature to prove identity, **proof** that you are entitled to register in relation to the property, and if there is more than one owner of the property **written consent** from the majority of the property owners. You may call the Village office 250-336-2291 to arrange the necessary documents in advance of voting day.

Accessibility at the Voting Place

The Cultural Centre has parking reserved for individuals with disabilities, an automatic door, and no step access to the voting place. Inside the voting place, a voter assist terminal will be available for voters with vision loss or a condition which makes it difficult to mark a ballot or a person may assist you to mark your ballot. If you are unable to enter the voting place due to a physical disability or impaired mobility, we can bring a ballot to you outside the voting place. Call the Village office for more information or to make arrangements beforehand.

MAIL BALLOT VOTING

To vote by mail, submit an application to the Village office by October 9, 2026 at 4:30 p.m.  
Applications to vote by mail ballot are available at [cumberland.ca/elections](http://cumberland.ca/elections) and at the Village office at 2673 Dunsmuir Avenue during regular business hours. In order to be counted in the election, your mail ballot must be received by the Chief Election Officer no later than 8 p.m. on General Voting Day on October 17, 2026.
